PLANTING DATES FOR AMADOR COUNTY GARDEN VEGETABLES

In general, at the lower elevations, cool season vegetables such as beets, carrots and cabbage have two recommended growing seasons. They may be planted in early spring or they can grow during the cooler fall. At higher elevations only one season is recommended

Warm season vegetables such as beans, corn and squash should not be planted until the soil is warm and warm weather is ahead..
